(Col 3:12-17)

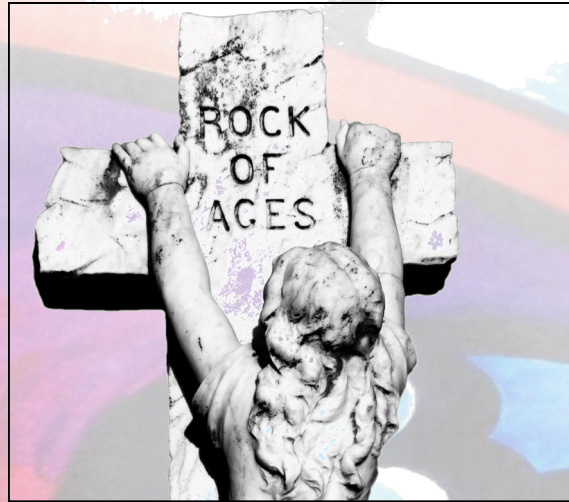
God loves you and wants you to have a right relationship with Him, one of fellowship, not rebellion. (John 3:16)

## There is a God who has made YOU for a purpose.

God created the world and He created YOU! His creation was perfect, but...we rejected God and His good plan for us. We wanted to live life our own way, without God. This is sin. It's not a small thing to reject your Creator. The consequence: death and eternal punishment.

God has made the way for us to be restored to relationship with Him through His only son Jesus. Jesus took the punishment that we deserved for rejecting God, by dying on a cross. The Bible says if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved! Repent of your rebellion and accept the forgiveness of Jesus and walk in the ways that God desires.

### To get your heart right with God—pray something like this....

Heavenly Father, I know that I'm a sinner and constantly do things that hurt you and others. I also know that because of my sin, I cannot have a relationship with you. I believe Jesus Christ is your son and came to Earth as a man to show us the way to you. I believe Jesus died for my sins. I ask that you forgive me for all the wrongs I have committed against you and others. I now choose to live my life in obedience to your Word, the Bible for the rest of my life.

I pray this in Jesus' name, amen.

### God changes you! What to do now?

Becoming a Christian is a total revolution of your life. You now have a relationship with the living God of this world, and not only that, by becoming a Christian He has sent His Holy Spirit to live inside you. God living inside you! Once you used to live for yourself, now you live for the awesome purposes and plans of the Creator.

Tell someone your wonderful news. It also means that others can support and encourage you. Do you know that all Heaven celebrates when one person comes to God. (Luke 15:3-7)

Ask someone you respect who is a Christian to help you learn more about God and who He is. Try to find a Bible-believing church to connect with. (Heb 10:24-25)



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### Continue your walk in faithfulness

The Bible tells us to keep close to God on a daily basis. The best way is to try to set aside a time to pray and read the Bible so you will get spiritual daily food. See if you can find someone to do a Bible study with or join a Bible study group at your local church. We all need support and encouragement. (Psalm 19:7-14)

It is a great idea to keep a journal of your journey so you can see what you prayed for and the struggles you have had as well as the wonderful answers to prayer as you see how God has worked in your life and the life of others.

#### How to Pray Guide

**Worshipping:** this is your chance to worship by telling God how much you appreciate Him. Take some silent moments with God so His Holy Spirit can minister to you.

**Confessing:** this is where you confess your sins for the way you have hurt God and others. Ask God's forgiveness. Truly being sorry means you will do your very best not to repeat that sin.

**Thanking:** this is your opportunity to thank God for answered prayer, food, clothing, safety, family and friends and all God has given us.

**Asking:** this is the time when you ask God to help you or someone else. Be specific.

Finishing your prayer, say: 'in Jesus' name, amen' to seal your prayer in the authority of Jesus.
